Top Five Kidney Disease Facts:

- 1. Every year, kidney disease kills more people than breast or prostate cancer.
- 2. Major *risk factors* for kidney disease include *diabetes, high blood pressure, family history of kidney failure and being age 60 or older.* Additional risk factors include kidney stones, smoking, obesity, cardiovascular disease and ethnicity of African American, Asian and Native Americans.
- 3. Because kidney disease has no symptoms, it can go undetected until it is very advanced.
 Protein in the urine is the earliest marker of kidney damage. Simple urine and blood tests done annually can detect how well the kidneys are functioning.
- 4. Men with kidney disease are more likely than women to progress to kidney failure. Black Americans are 3 times more likely to experience kidney failure and Hispanics are 1 ½ times.
- 5. There are 122,000 Americans *close to 1,900 are Louisianans* currently *on the waiting list for an organ transplant*. Of those, more than 100,000 need a kidney, yet fewer than 17,000 people receive one each year. On average, 12 people die every day waiting for a kidney.

More Kidney Disease Facts:

- Each year, over 110,000 people are diagnosed with kidney failure, over 50% of the new cases
 are attributed to diabetes. That's one person every five minutes. In 2016, Louisiana had 2,340
 newly diagnosed patients with kidney failure.
- More than 450,000 people in the U.S. are on dialysis and approximately 185,000 live with a functioning kidney transplant. There are over 10,000 Louisianans receiving dialysis.
- Kidney disease is currently the 9th leading cause of death in the United States.
- Medicare spent \$29 billion in 2016 to treat people with kidney failure; a total of \$87 billion (not including prescription medications) was expended for treatment in all stages of kidney disease.
- Obesity can cause kidney disease both directly and indirectly, and therefore, the
 obesity epidemic in America is expected to increase rates of CKD in the U.S.
- 26 million Americans have kidney disease and 73 million, that's

1 in 3 American adults is currently "at risk" for developing kidney disease.
